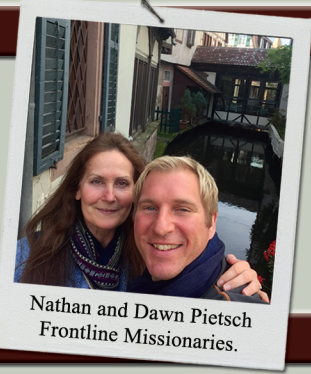

Are You Living in Fear or Faith?

The year of 2020 has been the most turbulent months in decades. There is a great social unrest that has swept the United States and is spilling over to other nations. All eyes are on the USA waiting to see what might happen. The possibility of civil war, mass rioting, governmental coup d'état, martial law, and food shortages have been conversation pieces. 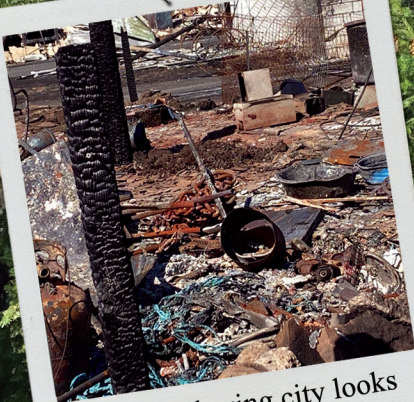

This car is completely burned out.



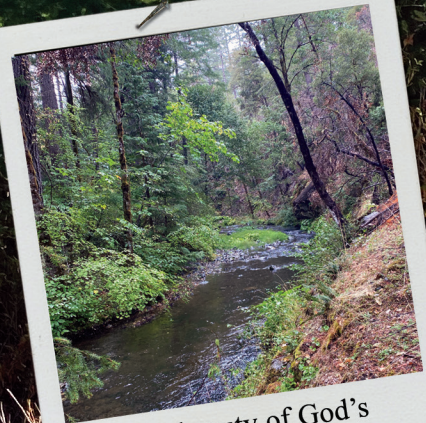
Our neighboring city looks like a war zone.
